Institutional Best practice-1

Title of the Practice: Preservation of Cultural Heritage through 'Khuel Jatra'

- To revive interest in dying art forms, artifacts, cuisine, dress, and music of Western Odisha and the tribal communities of Sundargarh district.
- To unearth and showcase hidden talents and skills among students.

Context:

Culture and tradition play a crucial role in shaping the identity of societies and individuals. Western Odisha, with its tribal dominance, boasts a distinct cultural identity rich in unique songs, dance forms, languages, and festivals. However, in the face of modern technological advancements, traditional practices are losing their appeal. To bridge this gap and connect the younger generation with their cultural heritage, it is essential to promote and celebrate these traditional art forms and customs.

The Practice:

The 'Khuel Jatra' was inaugurated on January 12, 2023, coinciding with National Youth Day.
