Report on District Working Committee Meeting of Youth Red Cross 2025-26

Date: 19.08.2025

Introduction

The Youth Red Cross (YRC) District Working Committee Meeting was convened on Tuesday, 19th August 2025 (19/08/2025) at 10:00 am onwards at the district nodal centre- Government College, Sundargarh with the support of Department of Higher Education and Mass Education, Government of Odisha. The meeting aimed at reviewing the progress of YRC activities in the district, discussing upcoming initiatives for the following year, and strengthening coordination among colleges/ HSS for effective implementation of Red Cross principles.

Objectives of the Meeting

- To propose an action plan including the recommended activities to be done for this year.
- To assess the performance and progress of YRC units across the district.
- To strengthen communication and coordination between YRC counselors, volunteers, and district officials.
- To recognize and encourage outstanding contributions by YRC units, counselors and volunteers.
- To deliberate plans on organizing various training programmes.

Proceedings

The meeting commenced with the lighting of the lamp and YRC song, symbolizing the spirit of service and humanity. The District YRC Chairman-cum-Principal (Sri Alok Ku. Naik) welcomed the dignitaries, counselors, and student volunteers.

The District Convenor-cum-Secretary YRC (Sri Ajit Ku. Sahoo) introduced our esteemed guests to the gathering.

The Additional District Magistrate (Sri Suraj Ku. Pattnaik) emphasized the role of Youth Red Cross in shaping young minds towards social responsibility.

The Emergency Officer-cum-Secretary, IRCS (Sri Aswini Panda) highlighted the importance of blood donation and emergency preparedness, encouraging volunteers to actively take part in spreading health awareness in rural and urban communities. He motivated counselors to enroll for lifetime service.

The Joint Secretary, IRCS (Sri Ajit Prasad) encouraged the counselors and volunteers by sharing real-life experiences of Red Cross service during emergencies.

The District Public Health Officer, Sundargarh (Dr. Sibashish Maharana) recalled the 7 principles of YRC- Humanity, Impartiality, Neutrality, Independence, Voluntary Service, Unity and Universality and urged the gathering to imbibe these values.

He further suggested the integration of all YRC units for effective management during emergencies and sharing success stories.

The Principal of Government Women's College, Sundargarh (Dr. Indira Garnaik) encouraged the YRC members to come forward in large numbers for community service, especially in health camps, blood donation drives, and environmental conservation activities.

The District Coordinator YRC (Sri Sumanta Dwivedy) presented a detailed outline on YRC activities to be undertaken during this year. He discussed the fund related issues in YRC units. He further encouraged counselors to be a representative of their respective blocks in order to ensure smooth communication. He took the initiative to arrange a training camp for YRC counselors.

Key highlights included:

The Counselor (Sri Pravakar Sethy, Government College Sundargarh) appreciated the dedicated service of YRC counselors. Resolutions Passed

- To schedule an induction programme for students in every YRC unit within two weeks.
- To organize a human chain event by YRC volunteers to show unity and cooperation and raise awareness.
- To conduct at least two blood donation camps in the district annually.
- To initiate 3-days district-level residential training workshops for YRC counselors.
- To actively functionalize Red Ribbon Club activities.
- To organize HIV AIDS awareness programme on World AIDS Day.
- To establish a YRC counselor coordinator at block-level for effective communication and mobilization.
- To recognize and award outstanding counselors and institutions with lifetime certificates during annual celebrations.

Conclusion

The meeting concluded with a vote of thanks proposed by the Counselor (Ms. Shivani Singh, Government College Sundargarh), expressing gratitude to all dignitaries, counselors, and volunteers for their active participation. The committee reaffirmed its commitment to uphold the Red Cross principles of humanity, impartiality, neutrality, and voluntary service.

HSS Counselors of Government College Sundargarh (Smt. Pragnya Paramita Das and Sri. Chintamani Kalo) were the organizing committee members whose tireless efforts have made this event a huge success.
